## Summer Camp Quilt

## Fabric Requirements

- 1 jelly roll ( $21 / 2$ " strips) or $21 / 2 "$ scrap strips
- 10 " squares -6 light color $\& 6$ dark color (or 2 contrasting colors)
*steps 1-3 are directions to make 8-at-a-time half-square triangles


## Step 1

Lay 10 " squares out, alternating 1 dark 1 light RST. Make 6 sets.
Mark lines diagonally, corner to corner, forming an X.

## Step 2

Sew $1 / 4$ " either side of both drawn lines.

## Step 3

Cut the sewn piece 4 times to make 8 HST (half-square triangles). This will give you 48 HST.
Square the HST to $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$.

## Step 4

Sew strips on the dark colored side of the HST, first with the short side. Trim, then the long side, trim, and repeat one more time. Blocks will measure approximately $81 / 2$ " squares. Square them up if you wish.
